

Research Grant

Through the generosity of Cook Communications Ministries, a grant of up to \$5,000 has been made available through NAPCE for research projects related to the Church's teaching ministry.

Application

Applicants should submit a current curriculum vitae and a proposal outline (1,000 words maximum) addressing the following:

1. Description of the research project
2. Budget and time-line for the project
3. A statement explaining the project's benefit for local congregations' teaching ministry
4. A plan for dissemination of findings

Conditions

1. Project proposals must be completed within a two-year time frame
2. Grant funds must directly relate to the research project. For IRS purposes, NAPCE will issue 1099 Statements for all compensation portions of grant funds.
3. Grant recipients must be members of NAPCE
4. Awardees will sign an agreement regarding handling grant funds and submit a project report at the completion of the project.

Criteria for evaluating proposals

1. Quality of the proposal: Does the project have clearly defined problems and goals, appropriate research methodology, and a realistic budget?
2. Promise of the applicant: Does the applicant have the necessary background and skills for the project?
3. Potential contribution: Will the research address a significant issue for the Church's teaching ministry? Will it benefit the work of local congregations and Christian ministries?
